PREFATORY STATEMENT

The Humanities area is the only part of the University's General Education Curriculum that has been sub-divided into distinct topic areas (Art & Music, Foreign Languages, History, Literature, Theatre). In recent years, the university has sought in various ways to promote interdisciplinary courses & programs, but this partitioned section of the General Education Curriculum seems at times to have impeded that effort. The articulation of an Interdisciplinary Humanities standard is intended simply to remove that impediment without changing any existing Humanities requirements in any way.

Goal 1

Students will meet all goals & objectives articulated in AT LEAST TWO of the five distinct Humanities areas (Art & Music, Foreign Languages, History, Literature, Theatre) currently included in the University's General Education curriculum.

Goal 2

Students will read, view, or listen to materials exploring the relationship(s) between the different Humanities disciplines included in the course.

Goal 3

Students will write about &/or take examinations covering the relationship(s) between the different Humanities disciplines included in the course.
